Spring Season Highlights

Boys' Volleyball

The team ended their regular season with a league record of 9-3 and an overall record of 21-12, tying for second place in the BVAL Mount Hamilton league. The team was the 5th seed in the CCS Division 1 bracket and started their playoff run on May 9th, but lost to Menlo Atherton in a close 25-23, 25-23, 25-15 match. Congratulations on a great season boys!

Badminton

The team finished their season with a record of 4-10 in the competitive BVAL Mount Hamilton league. Annie and Kerry Xu were Girls Doubles Champions at both the BVAL League Tournament and the CCS Championship meet - the third time they've won both titles! They had to miss last year's events while representing the US at the Thomas and Uber Cup in China, otherwise it may have been a clean sweep. Congratulations to Annie and Kerry! We wish them the best of luck as they continue their badminton careers as part of the US team - next week in a competition in Australia and for many years to come.



Track & Field

Leigh had fifteen top 8 finishes at the recent BVAL Meet in which all 24 teams in the League competed. Kyler Spindola won the 800M making him BVAL League Champion. Four Leigh athletes finished in the top 8 in more than one event including Nathan Viskovich (5th in the 200M, 3rd in the 400M), Hawa Kamara (4th in the 200M, 2nd in the 400M, and 2nd in the triple jump), Diego Rodriguez (6th in the 110 hurdles, 8th in the 300 hurdles), and Tevita Pahulu (3rd in the shot, 2nd in the discus). The other athletes with top 8 finishes were Tyler Elder (2nd in the pole vault), Nathan Yoder (3rd in the long jump), Matt Draxton (6th in the pole vault), Matthew Malvini (8th in the triple jump), and Shannon Sadler (6th in the high jump). In addition, the mens 4 x 400 relay took 2nd place and the womens 4 x 400 relay took 5th. Congratulations on a fantastic BVAL Meet.

The top finishers at the BVAL meet all competed at the CCS Trials this past weekend at Gilroy High School. Hawa Kamara finished 1st in the 400M and 3rd in the Triple Jump, qualifying in two events for this Friday's CCS Finals Meet. Hawa set a new Leigh school record with her 57.01 time in the 400M. Other top Leigh finishes and qualifiers for the finals include Shannon Sadler (#9 qualifier in the High Jump), Kyler Spindola (#12 qualifier in the 800M), Nathan Yoder (#7 qualifier in the Long Jump with a new personal best), and Matt Draxton (#9 qualifier in the Pole Vault with a new personal best). We wish all these athletes good luck as they compete with the region's best athletes this Friday at Gilroy High School. Meet starts at 4:00 pm for Field Events and 6:00 pm for Track Events.

Softball

The team capped their season with a win against Westmont on May 12th with a score of 9-4, highlighted by a home run hit by Sara Gayer in her last game played at Leigh. It was great to get the win on Senior Day, when seven seniors were celebrated. The Varsity girls finished the year 2-12 in the BVAL Mount Hamilton Division, 7-17 overall. The JV girls had a successful season, with a league champ record of 13-1 and 21-4 overall.



Swim & Dive

Leigh qualified swimmers in almost every event at the BVAL Championship meet, where the Varsity girls took 2nd and the Varsity boys took 3rd. Ben Dietz had an outstanding day, with first place finishes in the

200 IM and the 100 breaststroke). Other top Leigh finishers included Hayley O'Brien (first in the 500 free, third in the 100 backstroke), Ben Fritz (second in the 200 and 500 free), Sophomore Rachel Huynh (third in the 100 breaststroke), and Freshman Jenna O'Brien (third place in the 200 free). Both 400 free relays also finished strong, with the girls taking second place and the boys finishing in third.

The CCS meet took place on May 13th, with fourteen Leigh swimmers participating and three Leigh swimmers qualifying for the finals. Ben Dietz finished 13th in the 200 IM and 12th in the 100 breaststroke, Hayley O'Brien took 11th in the 500 free, and Ben Fritz finished 16th in the 500 free. Ben Dietz set a new Leigh school record with his time of 1:54.11 in the 200 IM, breaking a record that has stood since 1980! Congratulations to Ben and to all the Leigh swimmers on a fantastic season.

Golf

The team finished their season in 3rd place in the BVAL Mount Hamilton division, just missing the cutoff for a team entry into CCS. Connor Isaacson finished 7th at the BVAL League Tournament, earning a spot in the CCS Golf Tournament held at Laguna Seca Golf Ranch where he finished 31st in Region 1 with a score of 78. The golf team was honored to have three seniors compete at the Varsity level all four of their years at Leigh - Liam Hunt, Alex Llorin, and Jack Naillon. They will be missed!

Baseball

The team finished their regular season with a 11-3 league record, 19-8 overall, securing a co-League Championship with Willow Glen. The team received the 8th seed in the CCS Open Division playoff bracket and took on Capuchino at home on Wednesday. Leigh won that contest 6-0, with a no-hitter performance by Leigh pitcher Kanoa Pagan. Leigh played against Mitty in the quarterfinals on Saturday, losing with a final score of 10-4. Thank you to all of the fans that came out to watch the team play, and congratulations to the boys on a successful season.

Updates on Leigh Grads

Sam Delaplane, a Leigh 2013 graduate, is in his fourth and final year of playing baseball for Eastern Michigan University. The right handed pitcher is featured in the team's [2017 Baseball Season Preview](#) and has become a starting pitcher for the team. He leads EMU with a 2.70 ERA and 66 strikeouts in 15 appearances (seven starts) and 56.2 innings. His ERA ranks third in the Mid-American Conference, while his strikeout total is second in the MAC. His 184 career strikeouts rank 11th in Eastern Michigan laurels. In his last five outings, Delaplane has recorded 45 K's, including a career-high 12 against Ohio, April 14. Delaplane is also ranked tied for fourth in all-time saves with 10.

Kyle Morrison, a Leigh 2014 graduate, is in his third year of playing baseball for San Jose State

University. The infielder has played in 32 games this season, with 29 starts. His batting average is .245 with an on base percentage of .366. Kyle is 5th on the team with 16 runs scored, and leads the team with 8 sacrifice bunts.

Trevor Peterson, a Leigh 2012 graduate, scored a career-high 14 points on Senior Night at Point Loma Nazarene University. Trevor was nominated as PLNU's Comeback Player of the Year for his performance in his final basketball season with PLNU, a year that included the program's first appearance in the PacWest Tournament Championship game.

Teresa Danenberg, a Leigh 2016 graduate who was honored at last year's college commitment ceremony, is finishing her freshman year playing for the Sonoma State softball team and was recently named Freshman of the Year by her Seawolves Team. Congratulations Teri!


