Did you know that Leigh is well represented in the local roller hockey scene? The Leigh teams have been competing against other local high schools in the SilverCreek Sportsplex High School League for the past 12 years, and have built a very successful program along the way.

Former Leigh roller hockey athletes have returned to coach the current Leigh teams, and the program is managed and kept running through the dedication of current Leigh families along with the families of Leigh alumni.

Leigh has brought home a D1 Championship, a D2 Championship, and a D4 Championship in the last three years along with many other D2 and D3 Championships in past years.

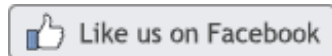
