



Leigh Winter Teams Off to a Great Start

Leigh's winter teams are about half way through their seasons and four of Leigh's teams are at or near the top of their league standings.

Girls' soccer is in first place in the BVAL-Mt. Hamilton division with a league record of 5-0-1. They have an overall record of 9-2-1 - very impressive given their pre-season schedule which included the strong soccer teams from Mountain View, St. Francis, and Woodside.
