Spring Sports - Finishing the Year Strong

Most of Leigh's Spring teams have finished their seasons, with four teams still in play as they move through CCS and NorCal playoffs. Highlights from the Spring season include:

Badminton

Leigh finished 8-6 in the Mount Hamilton Division. Seyeon Park, Lily Wu, and Negar Hosseini finished near the top in their rounds at the UC Davis Tournament. Annie and Kerry Xu, two time CCS doubles champions, are currently competing at the Uber Cup in Kunshan, China as part of the Women's USA Badminton Team (pictured). The Uber Cup is the premier badminton team championships for women worldwide and is held every two years. We wish them luck as they compete with top badminton players from around the world.



Boys Volleyball

The Varsity team are 4-peat BVAL Mount Hamilton League champions, going 12-0 in League, 27-4 overall. JV finished 10-2 in League. Four seniors were celebrated at Senior Night (pictured). The Longhorns worked their way through the CCS Division II bracket, defeating St. Ignatius and then Aptos to earn a spot in the finals against defending champs Saratoga last Tuesday night. The Longhorns played well but lost to Saratoga in four games. It was just the fourth loss for the team this season, with three of them coming against Saratoga. The team earned a spot in the NorCal playoffs starting on May 24th.

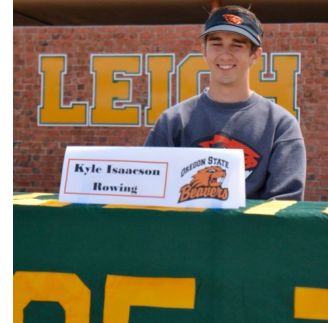
