a. **Fundraising:**

Taking on fundraising the rest of this year and next year. Looking how we can fundraise from a bigger perspective, across all sports. Thinking of ideas for the fall such as:

- i. Changing calling it Donation Drive instead of Membership Drive
- ii. Goal of \$19,000
- iii. Three donation levels and having an incentive for each.
 1. \$50 donation and you get a yard sign.
 2. \$100 donation gives you a t-shirt or hat and yard sign

- 3. \$250 donation gets a stadium seat, t-shirt or hat, and yard sign
- iv. Season Pass/All Access Pass for tickets for football, volleyball, wrestling, basketball – parents really like this.

b. Merchandise:

Elizabeth has officially passed the torch to Megan. We placed an order at California Sports Design to fill in some gaps with merchandise. We are going to do a flash sale of merchandise this week. East Bay merchandise order that Jake sent out allows for sports specific ordering.

c. Communications:

d. Senior Sports Program:

Sports Book is going great. The Sports Book is \$12. They have raised \$3,000-\$3,500 so far. They have fundraised enough money to cover it for every senior. They can offer sponsorships in the Senior Book and probably make a lot of money. We will not get this book next year – going back to cheer.
