Meeting started at 7:07pm

- 1) Welcome back –
- 2) Introductions
  - a. Board members, committee chairs, athletic director introduced themselves
- 3) Review and approve the June 2021 meeting minutes; motion to approve minutes by Megan Devlin, Maureen Currie seconded; passed unanimously
- 4) Treasurer's Report – Maureen Currie
  - a. Using the 2019 budget as a framework for this year's budget. During the meeting, we were informed that we won't be receiving any income from the membership cards so that reduces the income by \$8,000 and expenses by \$4000 (asb payment) along with other adjustments our proposed 2021 budget income: \$38,780 and expenses \$49,321 giving us a net income of <-\$10,541> a motion was made by Angie Lu to approve the proposed 2021 budget, seconded by Kris Suzuki; Budget passes unanimously
  - b. Question raised re specific team fundraising – to clarify; that is used for the sports team that raises their own funds. Briefly, three pots asking for donations 1) specific team, 2) sports boosters and 3) AD general donation
  - c. We would like to see more in-season coaches be present at meeting especially when asking for funds.
- 5) Revised bylaws put together in preparation of separating from HSC to own 501c3. A motion was made to approve the revised bylaws by Jamie Glanville, Josita Paschetta seconded and the motion passed unanimously
- 6) Committee Updates:
  - a. Fundraising (Rachel and Josita): have designed a multi-level fundraising program that includes some promotional items at different levels. It will be used at the beginning of each sports season. Also considering fence signs, community events, and other ideas. Communication being carried out via Facebook and Instagram, email, and teamsnap.
  - b. Merchandise (Megan): Working on inventory management and simplifying product lines. Will be looking into sales channels and ways to increase sales to help generate income from this branch of sports boosters. Looking at ways to grow her sales team.

- c. Communications (Angie/Jamie): Feel free to send content so that they can get the word out about sports boosters or teams. Goal is to represent all of the sports as much as they can so please send photos so they can send out updates
- d. Senior Athlete Recognition Coordinator (Alexis): New position charged with helping the coaches to be sure that the senior athletes are getting equitable recognition across all sports.
- e. Snack Shack (Kris): Parent run and largest fundraiser within sports boosters, historically raising approx. \$20K per year. She uses signup genius to manage volunteers. Will need a new BBQer for this season...Please sign up....
- f. Dining Night(Dana): organizing events at local restaurants for donations that come back to sports boosters

#### 7) AD Update

- a. Fall sports have started their tryouts or getting ready to start this week. Football scrimmages are coming up along with field hockey, water polo looks great, cross country also strong participation.
- b. Question re busing: need to find money; maybe need to do carpools
- c. No restrictions on spectators on outdoor sports and will need to wear masks for indoor sports.
