



**Sports Booster Meeting

- 1) Welcome
- 2) Introductions
- 3) Review and approved November 2021 meeting minutes: motion to approve made by Megan Devlin and seconded by Kris Suzuki and Angie Lu; motion approved unanimously
- 4) Treasurer's report:
 - a. Highlights: NI increased to \$9000.35 which puts us at 98% of budget earned from snack shack income (189% of budget, Go Kris and volunteers!!), merchandise sales (74% of budget), dining night out, and membership (78% of budget). Expenses came from sports specific account, bank fees, merchandise and snack shack. Overall NI \$21,591
- 5) AD Update
 - a. Fall sports performed exceedingly well with most sports being league champs and heading to CCS tournaments. Many players were first and second league teams. Congrats to all the fall athletes for their outstanding performance
 - b. Winter sports are in process and already doing well.
 - c. Recently moved the weight room to a more convenient location and coaches are asking about the possibility of a full-time strength and conditioning trainer for all athletics. Experience with football has been very strong and it seems as though it would be beneficial for other programs as well. The request is to have the funds that have been set aside for the medical trainer to be reassigned to funding of that position. Drew would be managing the conversations with the other coaches in order to a setup a schedule that will work for all those teams that want to participate. Drew will talk with the current trainer to see if he is able to be available for the winter sports 2021/2022 and spring sports of 2022. Motion was made to change the budget line item "athletic trainer" to "athletic trainer or fitness trainer" to provide a stipend for the seasons he would be able to cover for the rest of this year. Motion made by Maureen Currie and seconded by Kris Suzuke/Todd Varnell and passed unanimously.
- 6) Coach or Sports Rep Update
 - a. Boys and Girls soccer are both 1-0
- 7) Committee Reports

- a. Donation Drive/Fundraising: Looking for another push for donation drive this winter. Maureen is waiting to see what the check will be for Sports Basement. The Alina and Kendra Scott fundraisers needed to be approved by the district before we could move forward. They were approved on 12/2 so now they can start.
- b. Merchandise: The stadium chairs are a big success and the 1st 40 will be sold right away and the 2nd wave will be sold as soon as they are shipped. Pajamas are being picked up and sold.
- c. Communications: Fall highlights will be posted onto the Sports Boosters communication methods. Promote Kendra Scott fundraiser. Post
- d. Senior Recognition: Moving forward with collecting pictures for book from banners as each season goes forward so that getting book together will be easier.
- e. Snack Shack: Senior night was record setting and she is all set for baseball season.
- f. Dining Night Out – Pizza my Heart was approx. \$774 for the one night! Mountain Mikes will be the next event on December 15th.

8) New business will be tabled until next time

- a. Leigh Stampede – May 21, 2021. Stampede is happening and they are looking for a few volunteers for the graphic designs, sponsorships, and community advertisers/supporters. They are looking for ways to get the students more involved both leadership and athletes.
- b. Future fundraising guidelines will be addressed at another session to come up with process and criteria to be used to approve/disapprove potential fundraisers.
- c. Sports booster recruiting (Board, snack shack, BBQ) just to keep getting our name out to the community in order to get more people involved.
